Scripture Meditation of the Week

Act 17:24-25

"God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands. Nor is He worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things.

How many remember as children, or are guilty as parents of telling our children, that we go to God's house as if God can be contained in a building? David was a king and a prophet, but he desired more greatly to be a priest so he could be in the presence of God always. The idea that the Ark of the Covenant was in a tent repulsed him. The fact the God did not have a house to dwell in troubled him greatly. But God instead told David that he could not build a house for the Lord, but that the Lord would build David a house that would last forever.

That is our house; that is our home—the one that God built. We are to abide in Jesus. He cannot dwell in a building, but He desires to dwell in our heart, and for us to dwell in Him.

And as for worship, we think that somehow what we do, and what we can offer God, compares to what He created for and by Himself. Does your faith tell you that your efforts obligate God, the creator of all things? Then you serve a very small god, created from your own hands.
