Scripture Meditation of the Week

Galatians 5:22-23

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.

Paul encountered about a dozen believers in his missionary travels who were believers in Jesus, and yet they did not know anything of the Holy Spirit (Acts 19:1-7). Was not even aware of His existence let alone His role in our salvation or living a life that is pleasing to God.

Some believe they were not yet saved, and others believe they were, with multitudes of opinions on why that belief is held. And it is not a small issue since it leads to further understanding of how and when salvation occurs—the stuff of denominationalism.

But something that is interesting to note is that Paul baptized them again, in the name of the Lord Jesus—one can rightly assume as instructed by Jesus Himself (In the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit). But then He laid hands on them and the Holy Spirit came upon them and they received the gifts of the Spirit. Again, the stuff that divides men of good conscience.

One thing this illustrates is the often painful existence of those who want to live the Christian life apart from the power of the Holy Spirit. Do you question if you have the Holy Spirit in your life? Don't look so much at the gifts, but the fruit—for that is the measure. The fruit of the Spirit describes the nature of Jesus. When you are baptized in the Holy Spirit there is no question. Christian—are you filled with love for God and others? That supernatural love will lead you and keep you in the virtues of Jesus. It is when you do not have these things in your life that the questioning should begin. But here is more good news—you only need to ask, and your Father in heaven will give the Holy Spirit to you gladly and in abundance.
