Amos 3:7

Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

Biblical prophecy is pre-written history from the heart of the Creator and Sustainer of all creation who sees the end from the beginning. Since our God has seen fit to disclose it, as His children we should desire to know and understand it to the best of our abilities.

It is to show us that He keeps His Word in all things.
